DREAM OF CITY MAY COME TRUE

Announcement of Proposed Gigantic Nitrate Plant for Knoxville.

(Special to The News.) Knoxville, March 20.—Erection of a gigantic nitrate plant near Knoxville, similar to that proposed at Muscle Shoals, as announced by Washington officials, will mean the realization of a dream this city has entertained for years.

With the radius of seventy-five miles of Knoxville a survey made by the board of commerce for the war department shows that there exist waters powers still undeveloped capable of yielding a total of more than 600,000 horsepower. This figure is exclusive of powers under 5,000 horsepower, and of those now in process of being developed by private capital.

Greenville, S. C., March 20.—Nothing is being overlooked these days at Camp Sevier that might have the slightest salvage or even junk value. In a memorandum of recent date from division headquarters, published for the information and compliance of those concerned, various articles are named for conservation, and a method pointed out whereby they may be facilitated.

Bottles and glass jars which have heretofore been carried to the dumping grounds are now coming into warehouse No. 6 by the wagonload daily, where they are sorted and held ready for shipment. In consideration of the great amount of toothpaste, shaving cream, cigarettes, candy and chocolate that is used or consumed in the camp, the reclamation department has recommended, and in consequence thereof the division commander has ordered, that all tinfoil and lead tubes be saved and turned into warehouse No. 6, which is being used exclusively for the reclamation department for storage purposes.
