BUSINESS MEN LIBERAL THEIR HELP TO NEGROES

Support of Churches, Schools, Etc., Evidences Spirit of Co-operation—Many Hear Lecture of Myrtle B. Andrews.

(Special Correspondence) It is not generally known to what extent white business men of the city contribute to the support of colored schools, churches and charitable enterprises. This evidence of the spirit of co-operation, and the feeling of good will between the races, the Chamber of Commerce has its committee on "Race Relations," and the colored people have corresponding committees. Much good should result from these agencies.

The chapel of Howe Institute was crowded Tuesday night to hear Myrtle B. Andrews' address on "Unhyphenated Democracy." Prof. J. K. Glasper, president of the First Baptist church, presided and the choir of the First Baptist church furnished music.

Orange Mount is one of the most progressive of the colored suburban settlements. They have good churches and schools and are developing various lines of business of their own. They have neat, comfortable homes. A large per cent of them own their homes, and they are a peaceable, law-abiding people. The Southern Terminal shops furnish employment for many of them.

Prof. R. S. Grosley, of Jackson, Miss., is in Memphis today. He is president of the National Board of Missions and special agent for the Rosenwald schools in that state. Prof. Grosley has just held a conference of teachers at Clarkdale, Miss., in which several counties were represented. Patriotic and educational campaign is being conducted under the auspices of the National Security League.

Dean L. B. Moore, of Howard university, is in the city to confer with arrangements for the Ministers' institute, to be held at Avery chapel, Dec. 16 and 17. Cards of admission are being received daily from ministers who were invited to attend. The best homes of the city will be thrown open to these visitors, who are the leaders and representatives of their race.

The Baptist Ministers' alliance held their regular weekly meeting at the First Baptist church, St. Paul avenue, Tuesday, Rev. W. W. Whitton is president and Rev. H. M. Tate is secretary.

Pastors of churches are urged to call the attention of their congregations to the federal labor office on Howe avenue, where they may register for such work as they may be prepared to do. The government aims to serve the people in the matter of securing work.

"Keep moving." "Don't congregate." is the slogan.

There will be an important meeting of the Deborah circle at the Metropolitan Baptist church Thursday evening, Dec. 12, at 7:30 o'clock. All members are urged to be present.

Baptist Sunday schools and B. Y. P. U. organizations are making plans to attend the executive board meeting of the State Sunday school and B. Y. P. U. convention to be held at Covington, Tenn., Friday, Dec. 20, at Cannon Baptist church, of which Rev. W. C. Clark is pastor. A fund will be raised for education. L. C. Moore, of Memphis, will preside.

The disposition to start new churches and denominations among the colored people of Memphis should be discouraged. They simply mean new burials, and are not able to support the services of persons who teach and elevate them, hence they are kept away from light and helpful information. Religion will be more effective when it is made more practical and less burdened with cumbersome organizations.

BARTLETT PASSES WAR-LOAFER EDICT

Municipality Also Authorizes Many Improvements for Thriving Village.

If you are without visible means of support or are not engaged in a gainful occupation you had better not loaf around the town of Bartlett, or you will be fined \$25. The city council of that municipality Tuesday night passed on third and final reading a real war loaffer ordinance which will remain a law until the city sees fit to repeal it.

Bartlett also is preparing to build sidewalks and make other municipal improvements. With this end in view the council named a committee, composed of Ernest J. Reed, Mayor Charles Sedinger and Attorney H. Lee Bartlett, to arrange to sell bonds for \$5,000 to make the contemplated improvements. This bond issue was authorized before America entered the war, but the sale of the bonds and the improvement work was postponed on request of the federal government.

Prices of this war set aside as clean-up day for the town. Every citizen and property owner of the town is urged to gather at 10 a. m. on that day and assist in cleaning the streets of the town. Grass in yards and open spaces will be burned in order to lessen the danger of fire.

Mayor Sedinger also was authorized to see the chief of the Memphis fire department and secure data regarding the establishment at Bartlett of a fire brigade. The town is considering buying hand fire-fighting equipment.

Bartlett will hold a municipal election Jan. 1, New Year's day, to elect a mayor and six aldermen. The voters will then meet and name a town marshal and secretary.
