

## ANDREW CARNEGIE IS 75

Total Benefactions of Great Iron-master to Date Amount to Nearly \$175,000,000.

New York, Nov. 25.—In as rugged health as if he had passed all his years breathing the bracing mountain air of his native Scotland, Andrew Carnegie, the world-famous capitalist and philanthropist, quietly observed his seventy-third birthday anniversary today. A week ago Mr. Carnegie announced the gift of an additional \$2,500,000 to the Carnegie Technical Institute in Pittsburgh. According to the best figures obtainable the total benefactions of the great ironmaster to date amounts to nearly \$175,000,000.
