LANE PICTURES FREE AND GREATER EUROPE AFTER WAR

Raleigh, N. C., Nov. 8.—In an address before the State Literary and Historical association of North Carolina, Franklin K. Lane, secretary of the interior, pictured a future Europe as a result of the great war.

"One-half of the world is at war today," said the secretary. "We look with horror upon the inhumanity of human nature and say to ourselves: 'Is this all that Christianity has brought? Have we made no further progress than to make possible this reversion to the days of Attila? What has become of that sweet song of the brotherhood of man?'"

"But these are the words of an unthinking despair. 'Europe' may be 'burnt up.' Her people may be blotted by bankruptcy. Her national lines may be made to follow new channels. Her industries may be buried under a sea of mud. Her blood and the brain of many an unknown Tolstol, Beethoven, Pasteur or Darwin may be turned to dust and avaricious purpose may set up for a day new standards of national greatness. But these, all these, cannot destroy the passionate purpose of her people to own themselves, to find themselves and to decide for themselves what shall their future be. For chains and sacrifices must be made; these mean social life, and only the anarchist dream of a life without restraint. But Europe knows that it may have what we Americans long ago gained, that degree of freedom in which sacrifice is made—consciously and proudly made—for those and to those with whom we have a common interest. And this is liberty."

Sheep Attacks Infant; Mother Comes To Rescue But Is Herself Killed. Cheyenne, Wyo., Nov. 9.—Martha Kinneer, 26, was killed and her infant son was seriously injured Saturday when they were attacked by a buck sheep at farm 40 miles east.

The woman's battered body was found in the floor yard and the injured baby in the house by the husband, R. K. Kinneer, when he returned home several hours after the tragedy. It is assumed that the child was attacked by the buck and that the mother went to the rescue, managing to fight the sheep sufficiently long for the baby to gain the protection of the house.

ENGLISH NAVY INSPIRES U. S. TO WANT BIG FLEET. London, Eng., Nov. 9.—Presenting full details of the United States's plans for a greater navy, the Daily Telegraph states in a way of comment that "among the things the British navy has done is to convince the people of the United States that their country requires a large navy."

"We have," the Daily Telegraph adds: "the spectacle of the greatest democracy in the world, sitting apart from Europe by more than 3,000 miles. In such a hurry for more warships that it is decided not even to wait for the completion of construction and armament which the war may teach. Moreover, this decision has been reached by a party which came into power in opposition to the policy of the 'big stick,' and pledged itself to economy in armaments.

"The military in Europe have tempered the extreme pacifism of Americans. Although already possessing a navy held by many to be second in the world, they are determined to have a still greater one."
