

RAISE \$17,000 FOR NEW CHURCH

Alpine Baptists to Build Handsome and Modern Structure to Seat 800.

Alpine, Texas, Feb. 11.—Within the next 10 days the contract will be awarded for a new Baptist church in Alpine which, it is expected, will be one of the handsomest and most modern church structures in West Texas.

The new church will be built on the site of the present church building. The ground floor of the new structure will be used for the general auditorium and Sunday school rooms, which will be arranged to be thrown together when needed for a large audience.

A fine pipe organ will be a feature in the new church. Seventeen separate Sunday school rooms are to be provided and every modern device for Sunday school work will be installed.

The annual banquet of the Alpine Commercial club will be held Saturday night, Feb. 12, at 8 o'clock, at the Overland and Stanton streets.

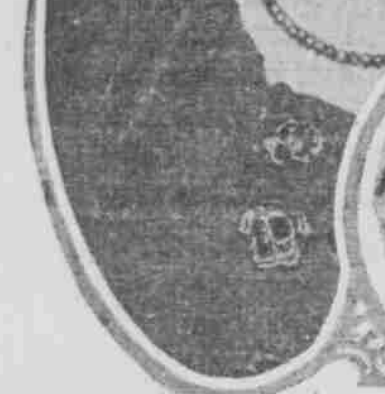
