

REDS OCCUPY ARMENIAN CITY

Constantinople, Turkey, July 24.—(By the Associated Press.)—The Bolshevik army advancing from Baku through Armenia, took Cochin, 244 miles northwest of Baku, virtually unopposed, as well as Geronzo, 24 miles southwest of Cochin, the next important town on the wagon route to the Tabriz railway. In Baku, the Bolsheviks are training a large Armenian communist army to assist in the overthrow of the Armenian republic.

RAINS CHECK FOREST FIRES

Phoenix, Ariz., July 24.—Rains conditions showed a marked improvement during the week ending yesterday, according to the weekly range report of the United States weather bureau, issued today. 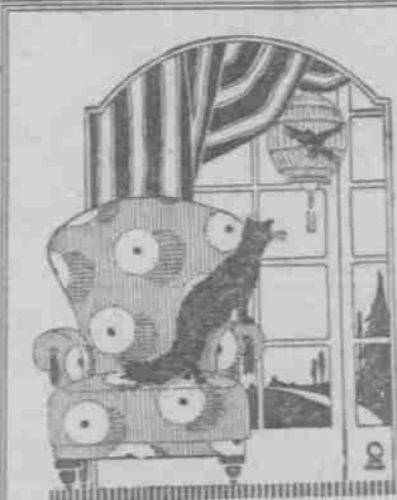
