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QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

Q. Who is the welterweight champion of the United States? E. T. W. A. There is no welterweight champion wrestler of the United States. Several men lay claim to this title.

The United States lighthouse service is under the department of commerce. The revenue cutter service and the life saving service are combined in the United States coast guard, which is under the treasury department.

Q. What is the meaning of the word "incorporated" when used in the title of a firm? Does it carry some modification of the word "limited"? F. M. K. A. "Incorporated" means that the firm has been granted a charter by a state, and that it is operating as a corporation. "Limited" means that the liability of the stockholders is limited to the number of shares held by each, and may apply either to a corporation or to a partnership.

Q. What percentage of our population is rural? A. E. The bureau of the census says that in 1910, 33 1/4 percent of the population was rural. An unofficial opinion of the 1920 census is to the effect that not such a large percent will be found still living in the country.

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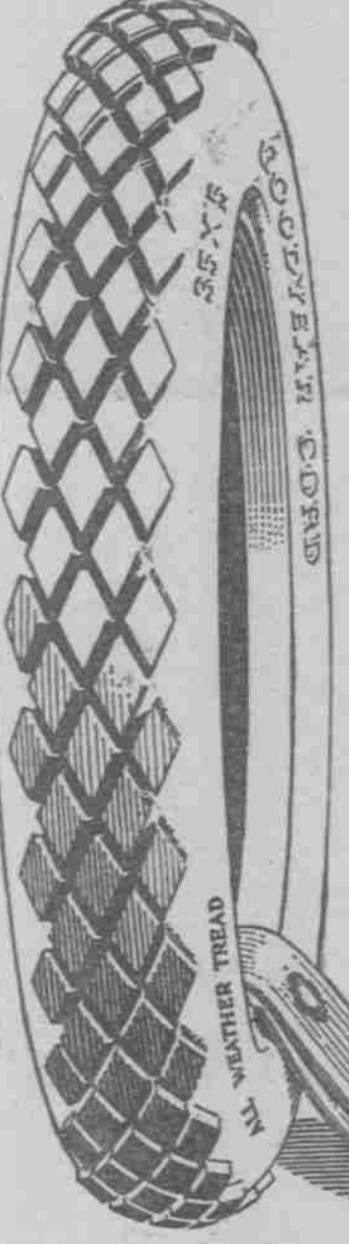
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
