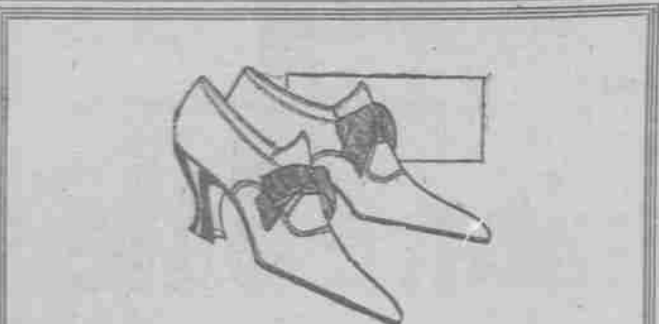


IS THERE ANYTHING IN FORTUNE TELLING? SURE THERE IS—ABOUT A DOLLAR AN HOUR
