"Nice swimming boys," she said. "I just wanted to see what you fellows make your best speed."

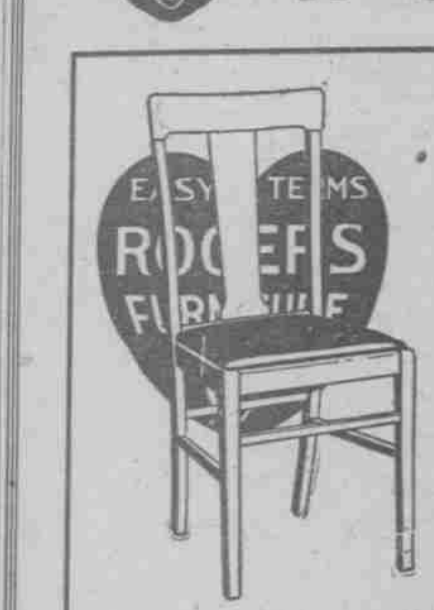

FESTIVAL HELD TO DISCUSS ARIZONA IRRIGATION PROJECT. Phoenix, Ariz., Aug. 12.—Hundreds of people from various parts of the state were in Florence today for a barbecue at the annual San Carlos day celebration. The celebration was planned to further the San Carlos reclamation project for the irrigation of many thousands of acres between Florence and Casa Grande through construction of the San Carlos dam in the Gila river. More than 100 automobiles filled with Phoenix people left here for Florence early this morning, while more than 100 went by train.

A feature of today's celebration was to be discussion of means of bringing the project to completion. Farmers of the Florence-Casa Grande valley were to discuss organization of a large central power plant in the valley to supplement the river flow and furnish power for pumping. Candidates for state office, subject to the primaries, were also to appear and make brief addresses. Delegations from various towns in the Salt River valley went to Florence early today and there was to be a crowd from Tucson.

TEN DRY ARRESTS IN PUEBLO. Pueblo, Colo., Aug. 12.—Ten arrests for violation of the prohibition law have been made by federal officers in a series of raids which began Tuesday night and continued all day Wednesday. Two of those arrested were women. All but one arrested have been fined \$300. The 10th man has been released on \$100 cash bond.
