

WEATHER AND CROPS.

The Long Drought is Broken in Travis County—A Fine Crop of Corn is Now Assured.

The Damage Done to Cotton Confined to a Narrow Strip in Fannin and Grayson Counties.

TRAVIS COUNTY. Special to the Gazette. AUSTIN, TEX., June 27.—A good rain fell this evening, which extended over a wide strip of adjacent territory and largely benefited the crops.

WACO, TEX., June 27.—The receipts of wheat and oats are large. Wheat brings 75 to 80 cents per bushel, and oats 22 to 24 cents.

CRAWFORD, TEX., June 26.—We were visited to-day by a nice shower and everything is looking fine. Crops are much better than was at one time expected during the warm rage.

JACKSONVILLE, TEX., June 27.—Very fine rains have fallen here recently and the crops are splendid.

OLDSBURNE, TEX., June 26.—A heavy rain fell yesterday. All the creeks and other water courses are full.

THOMAS SPRING, TEX., June 26.—By far the heaviest rain of the season fell here last night. It rained continuously for nine hours. The creeks were all out of their banks and great damage was done to fencing and crops.

It has been laid down as a rule governing the question of damages in suits for damages for injury to property, that the plaintiff cannot recover if his own act contributed to produce the injury, and if there is negligence both on his part and on the part of the company it is not a less degree of fault on the part of the plaintiff that will prevent him from recovering, but it must be of such a degree as to amount to a want of ordinary or reasonable care on the part of the plaintiff under the circumstances of the injury.
