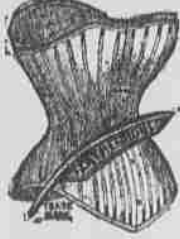

Miss Stella Holcomb left last week for her home in Luling, after a pleasant visit to her friends here.

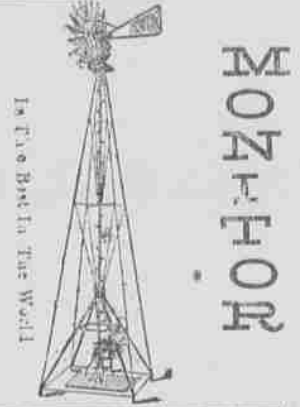
Miss Maud Chatham has gone to San Patricio where she is teaching school.
