I. W. W. S GET DOSE OF OWN MEDICINE.

BOMB EXPLODES WITH GREAT FORCE; KILLS FOUR.

Was Presumably to Be Used at Tarrytown, Home of the Rockefellers, Where Trials of Members of the Order Were to Take Place the Following Monday.

NEW YORK, July 4.—Three men and a woman were killed today when a dynamite bomb, said to be the most powerful ever used in the city, exploded with tremendous force in an apartment tenanted by Industrial Workers of the World. The upper part of the six-story tenement house in which the bomb was being made, was wrecked. A score of persons were seriously injured and much property damage was done in a wide radius from the scene of the explosion. Those dead and those who escaped injury in the apartment included I. W. W. men who were defendants in the trial to be begun Monday in Tarrytown, N. Y., where they were arrested for creating a disturbance a few weeks ago.

They went to the village to make demonstrations outside the Pocantico Hills estate and John D. Rockefeller, where John D. Rockefeller, Jr., had retired after being heckled in front of his office at 26 Broadway in this city by I. W. W. members and sympathizers, including members of Upton Sinclair's free alliance league. Their activities here arose from the coal mine strike troubles in Colorado, where Rockefeller has mining interests.

As soon as one of the bodies of those killed in the explosion had been identified as that of Arthur Caron, who came here from Boston and who was one of the defendants in Tarrytown, the police began their investigation of the explosion on the theory that a bomb was being constructed by Caron and others for possible use at the I. W. W. hearings in Tarrytown on Monday. Since the arrest of the agitators in that village there have been rumors of threats to town officials if the defendants were not released.

NEW YORK, July 5.—In the ruins of the tenement wrecked yesterday by the explosion of a bomb which it is believed was intended for use against John D. Rockefeller of his son the authorities found evidence today that Arthur Caron, who was killed with three others, had used his apartment as a center for the distribution of inflammatory literature and that it was filled with death dealing explosives.

A small printing press, revolutionary pamphlets and circulars, an electric dynamo, two electric batteries, cartridges and bits of steel, were among the articles uncovered which tend, in the opinion of the police, to show an anarchistic plot at assassination. That the demonstration, halted by the bungling of some one who was preparing the infernal machine for its mission, was planned against the Rockefeller family in Tarrytown, is the theory upon which the authorities are working.

CARBON COUNTY GETS ITS APPORTIONMENT FROM STATE

State Superintendent of Schools A. C. Matheson has issued the annual certificate of apportionment of money in the state treasury to the credit of the high school funds. The apportionment is made from a total of \$100,000 at the per capita rate of \$15.37, with 6502 students in attendance twenty weeks of the school year. Consequently the total apportionment aggregates \$99,825.75, leaving a balance of \$64.26 unapportioned.

The last annual high school apportionment, made June 1, 1913, aggregated \$97,145.10, when records showed a twenty week attendance of 5881 students and a per capita of \$17.10. Carbon county by the apportionment gets \$1752.18 on a basis of a school population of 137.
