

ENEMY WARSHIPS BEING ALLOTTED

France's Share Five Cruisers and Ten Destroyers, Half German, Half Austrian

PARIS, April 6.—(French Wireless Service).—Particulars of the distribution of enemy warships among the allied countries have just been published here. France's share, which is 10 per cent of all the tonnage of all captured enemy ships with the exception of submarines, represents 92,000 tons, half of which is in German ships and the remainder in Austrian vessels.
