INTEREST OF THE VOTES QUICKENED President's Appeal Stirs People to Action in Contests for Congressional Seats. NEW YORK, Nov. 4 - The closing of the campaign in the middle Atlantic and New England states today was marked by a general quickening of interest, in contrast to the apathy that characterized the early days of the contest. As a result of the president's appeal for support, a greater interest in the contests for congressional seats was apparent. In many states, however, gubernatorial and purely local issues overshadowed all others.

In New York the contests for 42 seats in congress attracted but little interest as compared with the bitter campaign between Governor Charles S. Whitman, Republican, and Alfred

E. Smith, Democrat, for the governorship. Liquor Question in Pennsylvania Pennsylvania's voters seemed to be chiefly interested in the liquor question, the Republican nominee for governor, William C. Sproule, running on a "dry" platform against Eugene C. Bonniwell, Democrat, who has been charged with being supported by the liquor dealers.

Senatorial elections held the center of the stage in many of the New England states. Former Governor David I. Walsh, Democrat, is opposing Senator Weeks, Republican, in Massachusetts. Representatives George F. O'Shaughnessy, Democrat, is fighting for L. Lebaron Colt's seat in Rhode Island; New Hampshire is concerned in two contests, between John B. Jameson, Democrat, and George H. Moses, Republican, and Eugene E. Reed, Democrat, and Governor H. W. Keyes, Republican.

The New Jersey campaign for senator has been enlivened by attacks of suffragists on David Baird, Republican, a candidate for re-election. West Virginia's principal fight of the contest is between Clarence Watson, Democrat, and David Elkins, Republican, while in Delaware Louis Hall is seeking Senator Saulsbury's seat.
