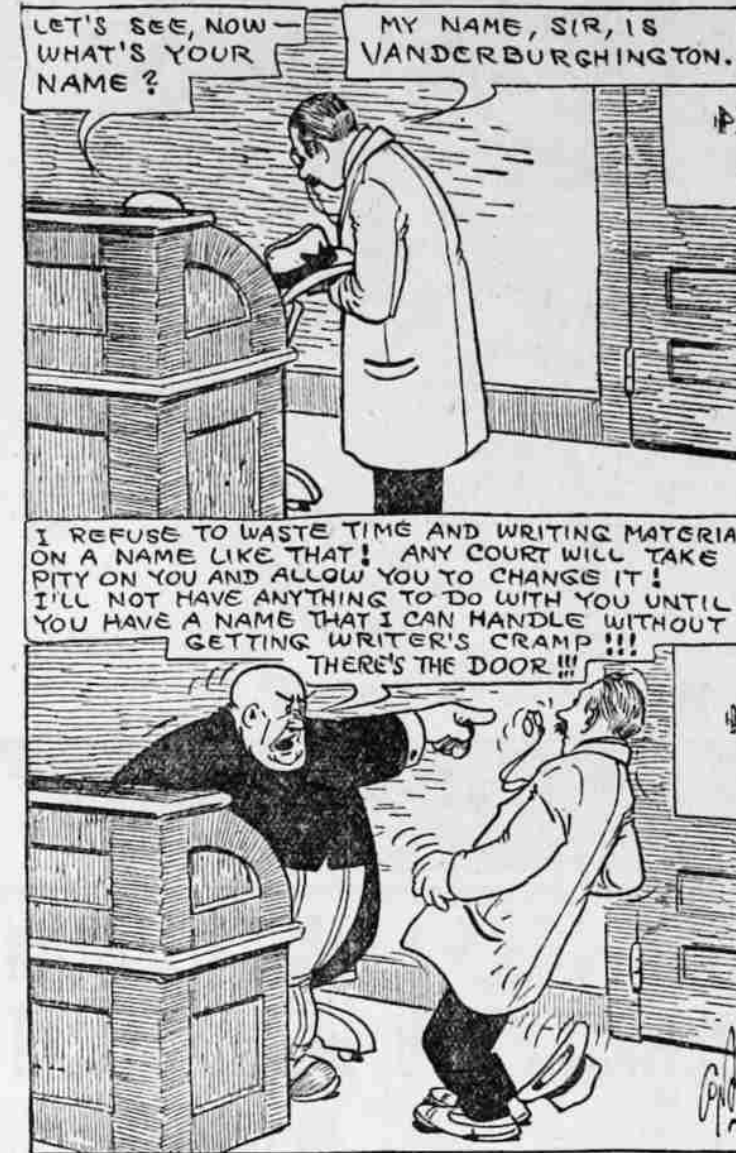

Daniels Asks for Increase of Navy of 25,000 Men

WASHINGTON, Dec. 31—Secretary Daniels asked the house naval committee today to provide for a temporary increase in the naval personnel of 25,000 men for the year beginning next July, leaving the question of a permanent peace-time personnel to be determined later. He also sought authority to transfer 1,000 officers among the reserve force to the permanent naval establishment. Mr. Daniels also asked the committee to write into the new appropriation bill a provision making permanent the war-time pay increases for enlisted men. This would give increases of \$6 to \$15 a month over the pre-war scale, making the pay range from \$36 to \$51 a month.
