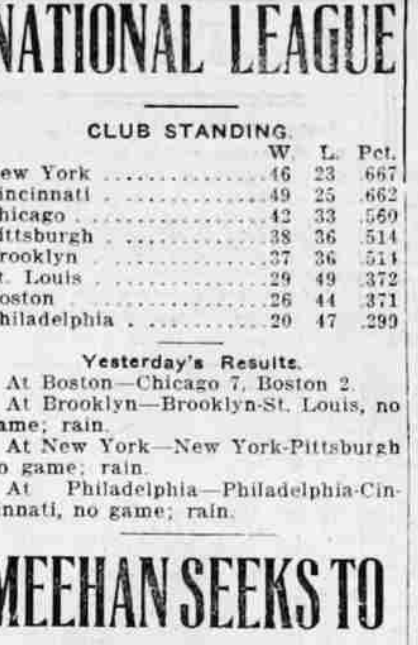

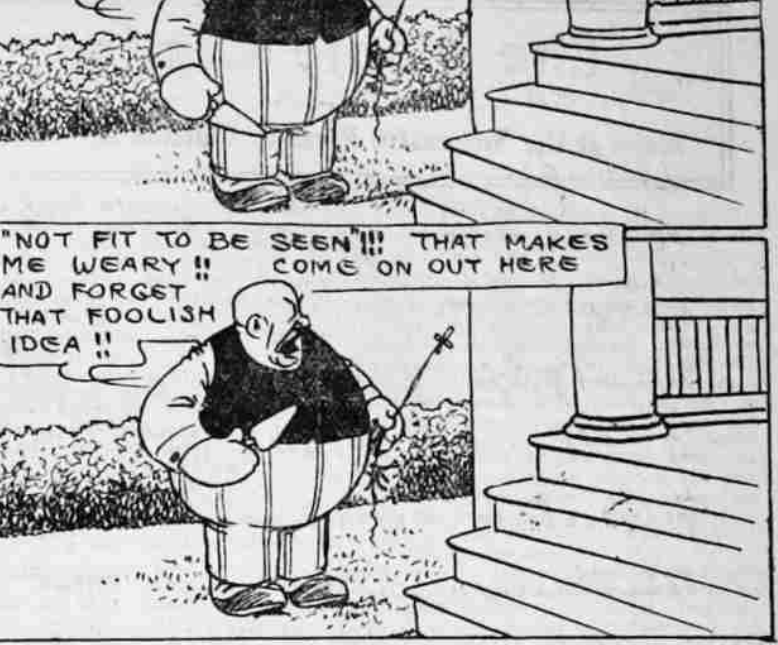
MEEHAN SEEKS TO FIGHT DEMPSEY

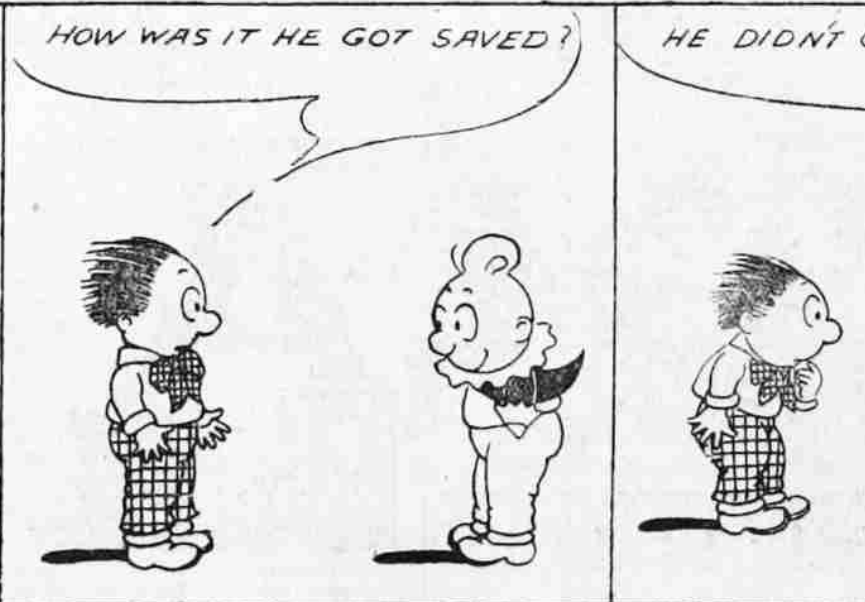
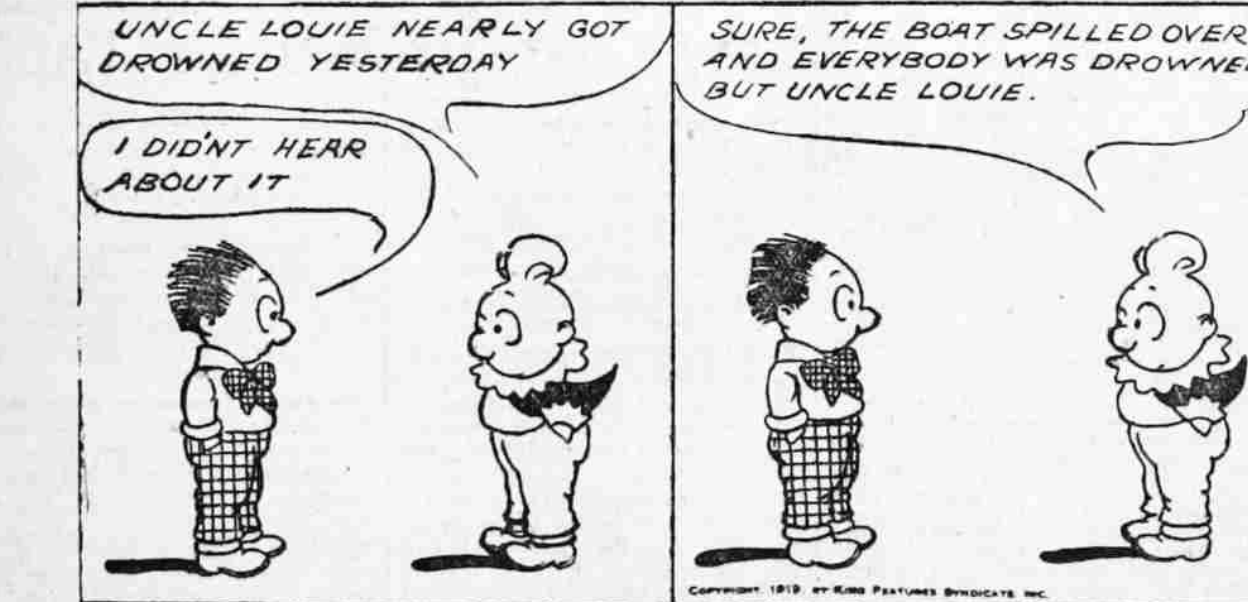

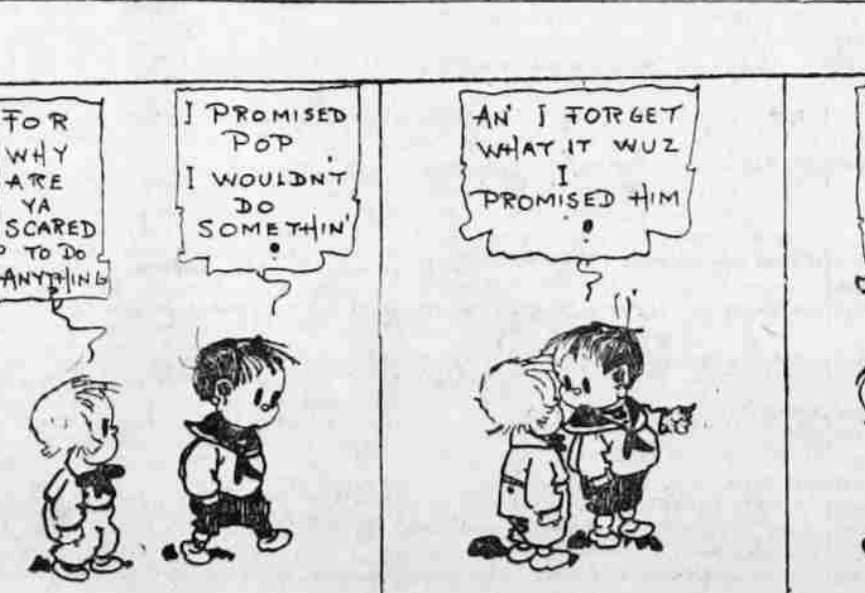
