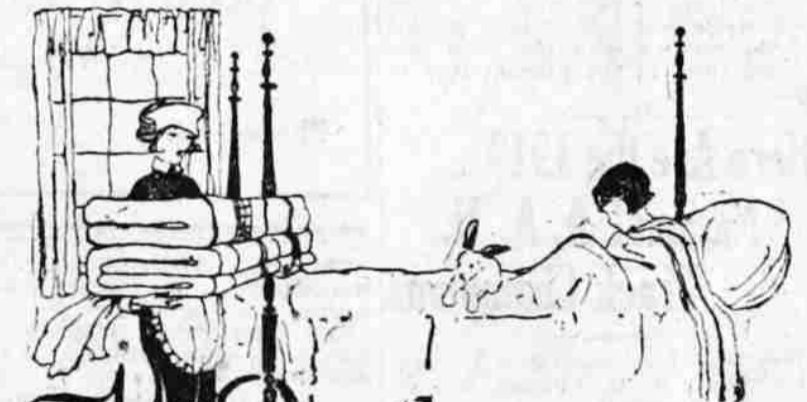

HAWAIIANS FEAR TIDAL WAVE IN HILO WATERS

HILO, T. H., Oct. 4.—(By The Associated Press.)—A crack half a mile south of the summit crater of Volcano Mauna Loa was reported today by Professor Thomas A. Jagger, United States volcanologist, who returned to Hilo from the scene of the eruption. Lava is filling the crack two miles above the cone caused by the 1916 eruption, according to the professor, and lava spouted from the cone 200 feet into the air when the disturbance was at its height. Professor Jagger said that in Lava lake on the summit he found a huge fountain of molten lava and that the gas pressure was enormous.

Reports from the peak indicate that the flow is increasing and Hawaiians fear another tidal wave, such as endangered the lives of canoe men and others Thursday.

A bright glow caused when the hot lava comes from the volcano is reported by observers.

No loss of life is believed to have resulted from the eruption and property damage has been slight, the flow for the most part being through desolate country.

Henry S. Dennison To Succeed Gay at Industrial Meeting

WASHINGTON, Oct. 4.—Henry S. Dennison of Framingham, Mass., was named today by the department of labor as representative of the general public at the industrial conference which opens here Monday. He takes the place of Edwin F. Gay of Cambridge, Mass., who is in Europe.

The national industrial board announced its delegates as follows: Frederick P. Fish and Edward Farnham Greene, Boston; J. M. O'Leary, Chicago; and C. Pemberton Hutchinson, Philadelphia.

Women are Being Discharged From Railroad Service

WASHINGTON, Oct. 4.—The number of women employed by railroads in heavy war work while the war was on and when men could not be obtained is being reduced steadily. Director General Hines announced women employed in all occupations on federal controlled roads July 1 were 4.9 per cent fewer than on April 1, but those working in roundhouses had been reduced 23.6 per cent and in shop work 13 per cent.
