J. Frank Hanly, Former Governor of Indiana, Accident Victim

DENISON, Ohio, Aug. 2.—J. Frank Hanly, former governor of Indiana, a prohibition candidate for president, in 1916, and Dr. and Mrs. C. M. Baker of Kilgore, Ohio, were killed six miles from here today when a Pennsylvania freight train ran into their automobile.

BORN IN CABIN. INDIANAPOLIS, Aug. 2.—J. Frank Hanly was born April 4, 1863, in a log cabin in Champaign county, Illinois. He secured his education by working his way through school, then taught school.

DRY WORKER. When his term expired in 1909 he became an active worker in the prohibition cause and for five years toured the country at head of a body of prohibition lecturers known as the "flying squadron."

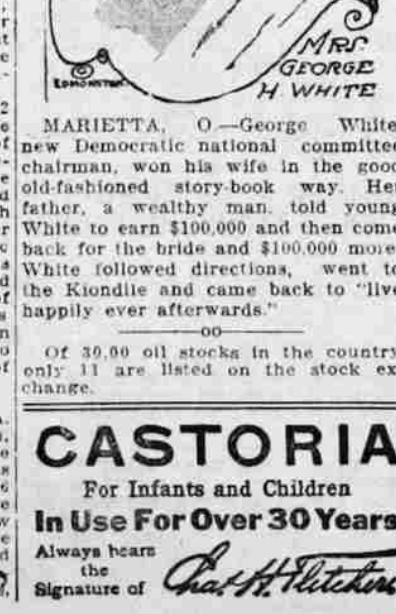

CAMPAIGNS PUT ON THRIFT BASIS

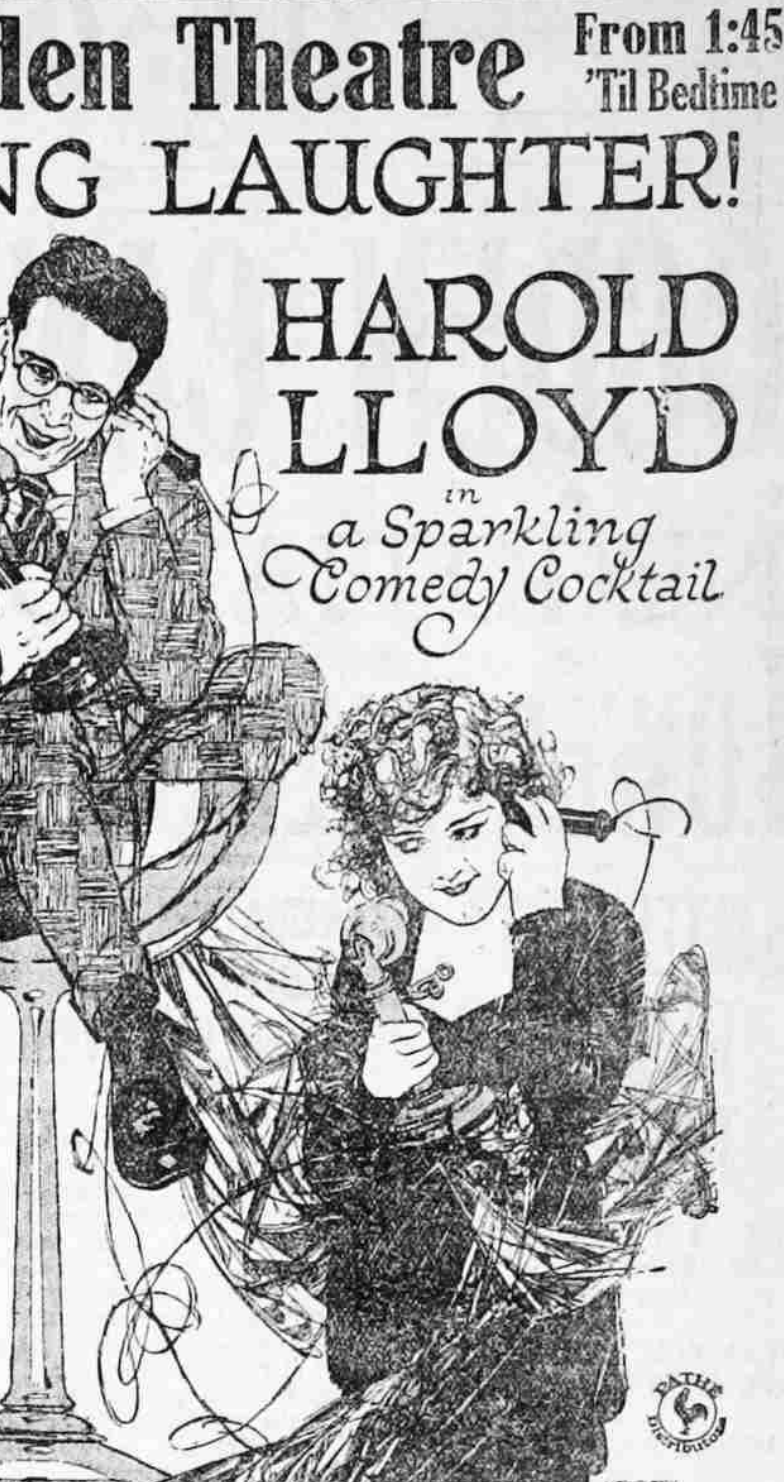
