

# THOUSANDS SEE FARM EXHIBITS

### Fair Arranged Under Direction Of Club Leader and Farm Bureau

Thousands of people from all portions of Weber county were present yesterday at the Farm Bureau and the county school exhibit at the Lorin Farr park auditorium.

The fair, which was arranged under the direction of E. W. Robinson, county club agent, Miss Ellen Agren, county demonstration agent, W. P. Thomas, county agricultural agent, and Miss Edith Hestball, secretary of the Weber Farm Bureau, was declared to be a far greater success than the one held last year.

#### GIRLS' HANDWORK

Probably the most attractive exhibits were those in which examples of county girls' needlework were displayed. Dainty garments of all descriptions, beautiful embroidery work, crochets, tatting, lace, lace-making, and practically all kinds of sewing, were on exhibition. One of the most striking exhibits was a hand-woven rug, made up of braided bits of old rags.

The fruit and agricultural exhibits were also exceptionally good. Watermelons weighing 25 to 50 pounds, were displayed. Gigantic squash, luscious peaches, unusually large and other fruits were displayed. The sugar beet display was one of the largest at the fair. Scores of enormous sugar beets were lined along a long table and it is estimated that over a ton of beets were in the exhibition. Pets of the club members made no small part of the fair and a large section of the hall was given over to spaces for rabbits, chickens, geese, and ducks.

The carpentry exhibit attracted much attention. Fly traps of unique design had been prepared by the boys and it was noted that the traps which were constructed more roughly and which resembled a barrel, attracted the most of the winged insects. One of the traps, constructed from screen and old hoops, contained nearly half a bushel of deceased flies.

Many youngsters hovered about the baking exhibit and gazed longingly at golden-crustied biscuits, highly decorative pies, cakes of all kinds and sorts, and other products from ovens in the country.

This exhibit was one of the best in the auditorium.

The flower exhibit was interesting. Gigantic bouquets of colorful fall blossoms, tastefully arranged, caused many to gaze at the bouquets, and if no one was looking, surreptitiously appropriate a nosegay.

#### LIVESTOCK ON DISPLAY

Under the grandstand in the ball park, stalls for sheep and swine had been arranged. A number of excellent specimens of sheep were on display here, and several blooded pointers, also wallowed contentedly, a blue-ribbon bedecking their stalls.

Throughout the event the large crowd was enthusiastic over the affair. County commissioners, representatives of the Amalgamated Sugar company, and other organizations from Ogden were present and seemed to be enjoying themselves immensely.

The celebration terminated with a dance.

## MAKES HAT IN TWO HOURS AND WINS CONTEST

The women had never attempted to make hats prior to receiving instructions through Miss Ellen Agren, county demonstration agent.

They seated themselves in the center of the Lorin Farr pavilion and for two hours were busy plating needles and shaping their hats. Although the headdresses were not completed at the end of the two-hour time, they had been whipped into shape and compared well with store bonnets.

### Business College at Weber Opens Monday

Registration will begin at the Weber Normal business college tomorrow morning at 9 o'clock. New equipment has arrived and will be installed in time for use by the students when instruction begins.

A new member of the faculty was announced yesterday. He is Horace G. Clark, formerly of the commercial school of the Utah Agricultural college.

### New Registration Days Designated

Announcement that registration days will be held Monday and Tuesday, Sept. 20 and 21, for children who have to attend school under the Utah State law which requires all persons between the ages of 14 and 18 years of age, was made yesterday by Principal A. M. Merrill of the Ogden High school, and Dr. T. E. Legins, principal of the part time school.

Registration days were held September 13 and 14, but a large number of students who were supposed to register, failed to do so.

The school law will be rigidly enforced this year, it is said.
