Idaho Governor Assures That Survey of Project Will Be Started

POCATELLO, Ida., Oct. 12.—People of the Big Lost River project have been assured by Governor Davis that the state of Idaho, through the department of reclamation, will begin a survey of the proposed plan to divert part of the waters of the upper Salmon river for irrigation purposes in Central Idaho. In a letter to John Hurst last week, the governor stated that Commissioner Swenson would take the matter up at the first opportunity.
