GREEL COMING FROM MEXICO

Reported Working for Recognition of New Government By United States

WASHINGTON, Oct. 15.—George Creel, former chairman of the committee on public information, is returning to Washington from Mexico City to work for the immediate recognition of the present government of Mexico, according to advices from the Mexican capital today quoting an interview with Creel published in El Herald, the official government organ.

Creel had a conference of six hours with Provisional President de la Huerta immediately on his arrival in Mexico City, in company with Roberto V. Pasquiera, financial agent of the Mexican government in Washington.

Creel and Pasquiera left this morning for the United States and Creel was quoted that on his arrival in Washington he would see President Wilson.

In the course of the statement as published in El Herald, Creel attacked the state department for interference in the controversy between the United States and Mexico. He declared the controversy was one strictly between the companies and the Mexican government with which the United States government should not have concerned itself.

U. S. AND CANADA JOIN TO STUDY FISHERIES

WASHINGTON, Oct. 15.—The United States, Canada and Newfoundland are to appoint three members each on an international committee on marine fishery investigations under an agreement reached at an informal conference held last month in Ottawa. Details of the conference were made public today by the state department.

PRES. OREGON STARTS FOR FAIR AT DALLAS

AUSTIN, Tex., Oct. 15.—General Alvaro Obregon, president-elect of Mexico, left El Paso for Dallas this morning, according to advices received by Governor Hobby, who, his secretary said, will join the general at Fort Worth tomorrow morning and accompany him to the state fair at Dallas.

MEXICAN VOLCANO RUMBLES; PEOPLE PREPARE TO FLEE

MEXICO CITY, Oct. 15.—The volcano Popocatepetl, 26 miles west of the city of Puebla, is reported to be in eruption with much steam escaping and deep rumblings, according to dispatches from Puebla today.

STOCKMEN AIDED RAISING HORSES

(By International News Service.) WASHINGTON, Oct. 15.—In order to improve the breed of horses of America, the war department, during the next year will place at the disposal of farmers and stock growers throughout the entire country, a number of some of the finest thoroughbreds now registered in the American Stud Book according to an announcement recently by Adjutant General C. H. Harris.

TO INCREASE STALLIONS

The announcement of the adjutant general states that the department in 1921 will triple the number of thoroughbred stallions owned by the army. There are now forty-five thoroughbred stallions and two Arab stallions at the army remount centers. These additions will come largely from gifts by thoroughbred breeders and horsemen, acceptance of which has been authorized by the secretary of war. Money for prizes at state and county fairs also has been presented.

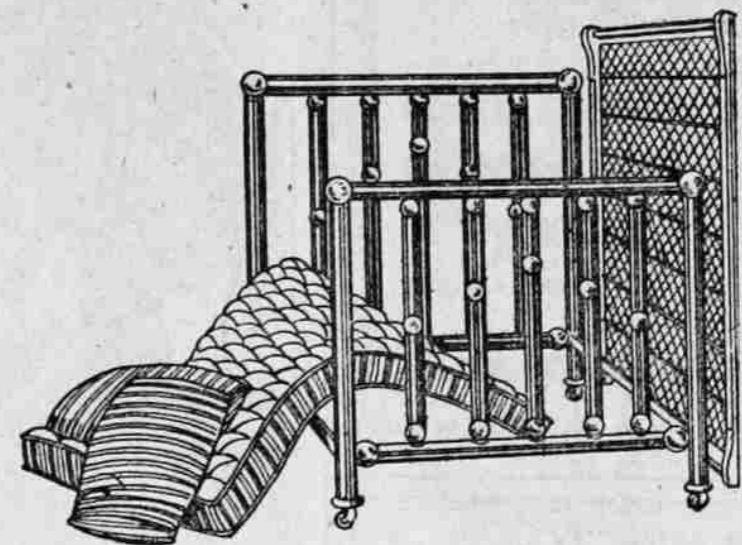
