

COOLIDGE TALKS ON UNION LABOR

Fears Power of Organized Workers Just as Much as Organized Capital

BOSTON, Nov. 24.—Vice President-elect Coolidge, speaking last night before a group of Boston business men asserted that in the last election the country had expressed its opinion against organized labor as it had a few years ago against organized capital and warned against the danger that labor might be divorced from a part in the government just as organized capital had been divorced.

ON AIMS OF LABOR

In his reference to organized labor, Governor Coolidge recalled that in an address to Dartmouth college last winter he had pointed out the growth of corporate wealth, which had brought with it the fear that it would undermine the foundations and dominate our government, and that this fear resulted in the curtailment of corporate power and influence in our government.
