WASHINGTON, Dec. 18.—A bill appropriating \$300,000 for the purchase of Antelope Island in Great Salt Lake for a national bison range and game preserve, to be known thereafter as the Utah National Game Preserve, has the Utah National by Representative of \$400,000,000 during the next four

Any public land on the island will, under the bill, be added to that portion which is to be purchased. Out of the sum appropriated not more than \$30,000 is to be spent for the purchase of buffalo now on the island at not more than \$150 per head; \$10.000,000 a year for the next four years, thus continuing the present co-operative public road construction. On the recommendation of Secretary and other improvements and for warden service for the first year. Once the reserve is created the bill makes it unlawful to kill any buffalo, game or birds of any kind on the island.

The bill introduced by Congressman Welling is the result of agitation which started when it was announced that the newly organized Buffalo. Island livestock company had taken a lease on Antelope Island from the Dooity estate. The company proposed to put several thousand head of beef cattle on the island, and this made it necessary to destroy or transport the bison there now.
