Chinese 'Killers' Convicted in Nevada Face Lethal Chamber While Legal Battle Rages

LEGAL BATTLE ON. In the meantime, a bitter legal battle has opened in Nevada to stop the use of the lethal gas case as a means of capital punishment.

As for Hughie Sing, 19, and Gee Jon, 29, they merely know that they are doomed to die. They have no conception of the scientific device, born of the war, that may carry them to momentary fame as well as to death.

Hughie Sing, who attended American schools but could not forget lessons in long vengeance learned outside the classroom, says he is not a murderer.

"ONE WAY LIKE ANOTHER." Hughie is more interested in the course of the courts than in the means of death.

"I know I have been sentenced to death, that is all," he says. "I do not want to die, but what am I to do?"

Thousands of protest letters are pouring in on state officials, charging that lethal gas killing is "inhuman," "cruel and unusual punishment" and "the last word in refined torture."

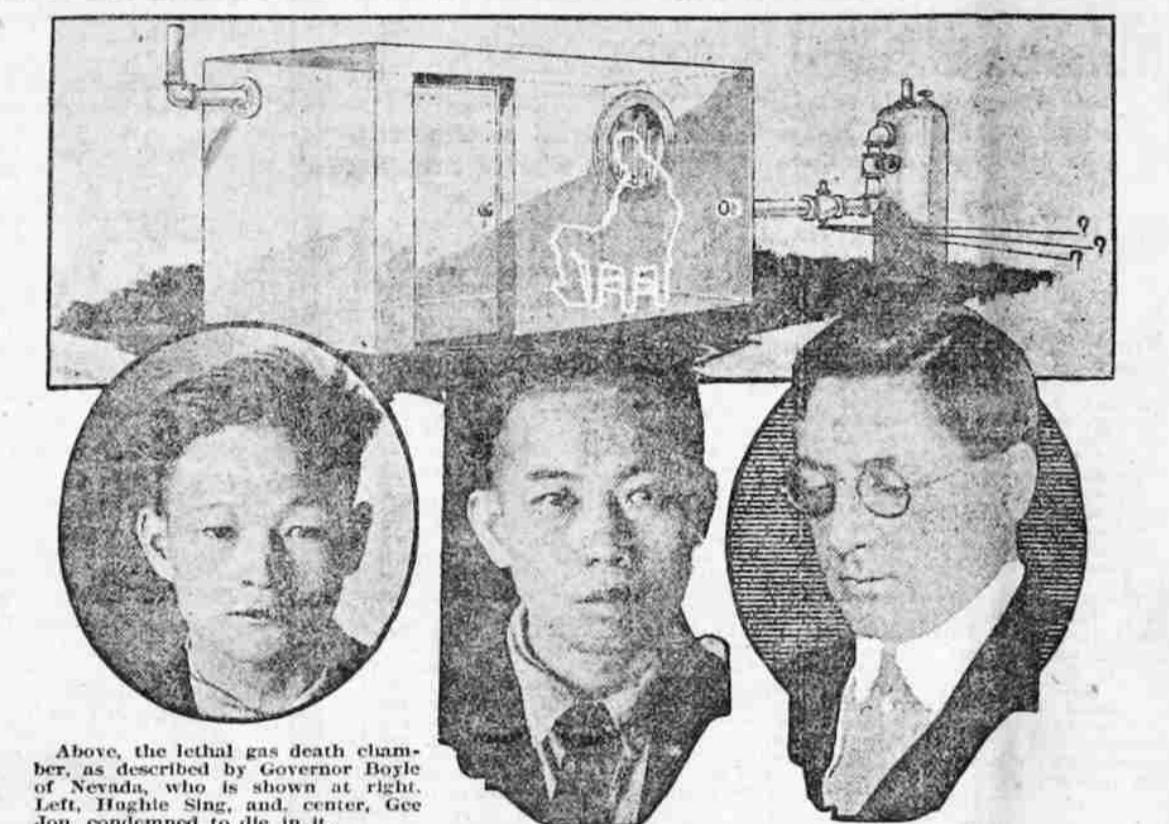
DEATH HOUSE DESCRIBED. A small concrete death house, about 5x7x8, will be built in one corner of the prison yard.
