

LIST DECLINES UNDER SELLING

Losses of 1 to 3 Points Suffered By Most Active Issues

NEW YORK, Sept. 27.—Speculative operations in today's stock market were again on the selling side, with resultant declines of 1 to 3 points in most active issues.

Threats of war in the Far East still cast a dampening influence over the stock market at today's opening.

Indications that the early bidding up of the oil shares was used as a screen to unroll speculative positions caused some profit taking in Standard Oil groups later, California and New Jersey being carried down a point below Tuesday's final figures.

Passing of the quarterly dividend of 1 1/2 per cent on Pittsburgh Coal gave a renewed impetus to prices after midday.

Sensing the absence of fresh buying power, short interests continued their attack in the final hour, being aided by the liquidation of small holders.

The closing was weak.
