

FLEET IN ORIENT IS ORDERED TO RETURN

United States No Longer Fears an Outbreak in the Republic of China.

WASHINGTON, June 19.—A sign of the confidence of the state department in the stability of the new Chinese government and its ability to maintain law and order, was the order issued from the navy department today for the return to the United States of Admiral Sutherland with his flagship California and the armored cruiser

South Dakota with the supply ship Glacier. With the big cruisers Colorado and Maryland, which have already returned to the Pacific coast, these vessels were rushed to China from Hawaii several months ago when conditions looked very dark for the Chinese republic. Rumors that Premier Tong-Shao-Yi had abandoned his office and fled from the capital were contradicted today by state department advices that he had been granted five days' sick leave. To meet immediate necessities of government, the international group of bankers have agreed to make another advance of three millions taels. Meanwhile these bankers are continuing their conferences in regard to the issue of the larger federal loan to China, and progress is being made.

Pardoned by Taft. WASHINGTON, June 19.—President Taft today pardoned Franklin P. Mays on the ground that government prosecutors had pursued improper methods in securing his conviction of land frauds at Portland, Or., in 1907. This is the second pardon granted by the president in the famous Mitchell-Hermann land cases. Willard N. Jones was pardoned a few days ago.

ARSENIC FOUND IN LIVER OF LINDLOFF

CHICAGO, June 19.—Arsenic in large quantities has been found in the liver of Arthur Lindloff, whose mother, Mrs. Louise Lindloff, is under arrest in connection with his death, according to a report by Professor Walter S. Hains, submitted to Coroner Hoffman today. After receiving the report of the chemical analysis, Coroner Hoffman obtained an order for the examination of the bodies of William Lindloff and Aina Lindloff, husband and daughter, respectively, of the accused woman. The vicars from their bodies also will be examined by Professor Hains. Mrs. Lindloff's arrest followed the sudden death of her son June 13. Five deaths that have occurred in her family in the last three years are to be investigated. All of the dead persons were insured in her favor, it is alleged.
