May Prevent John A. Harrington of Chicago From Appearing as Witness.

LOS ANGELES, Cal., June 20.—An unexpected assault was made by the defense today on the eligibility as a witness of John A. Harrington in the trial of Clarence S. Darrow for alleged jury bribery.

The defense objected to further questioning on the ground that the statutes forbid the examination without the consent of the employer of any attorney, secretary, or clerk of an attorney concerning any fact, knowledge of which had been acquired in such capacity.
