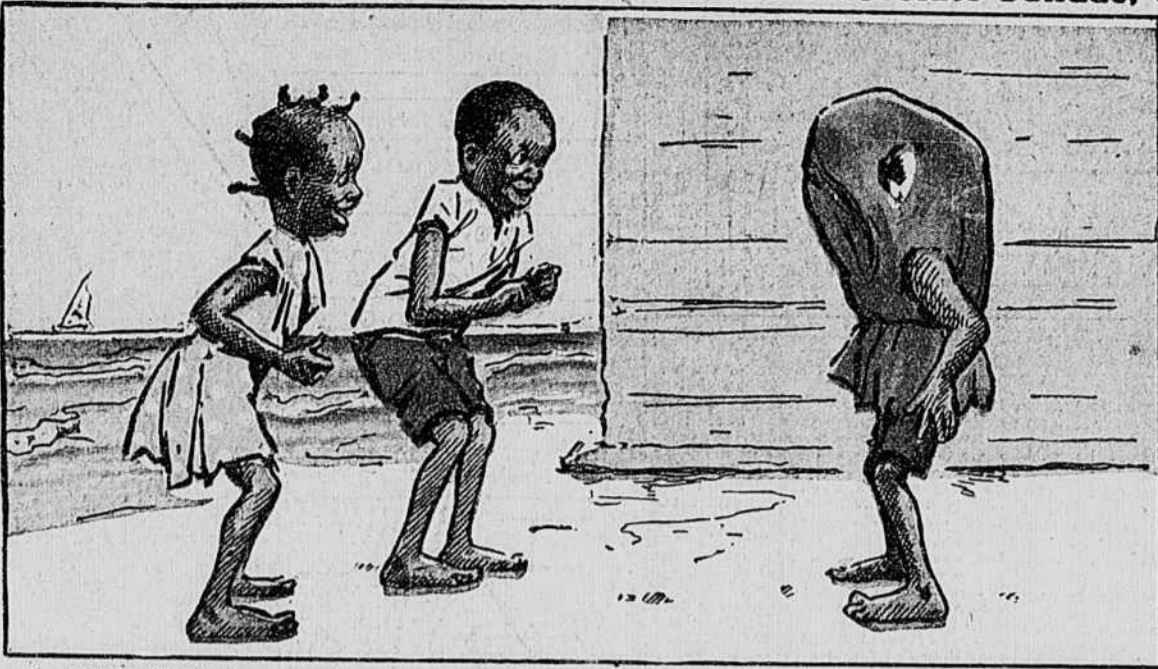

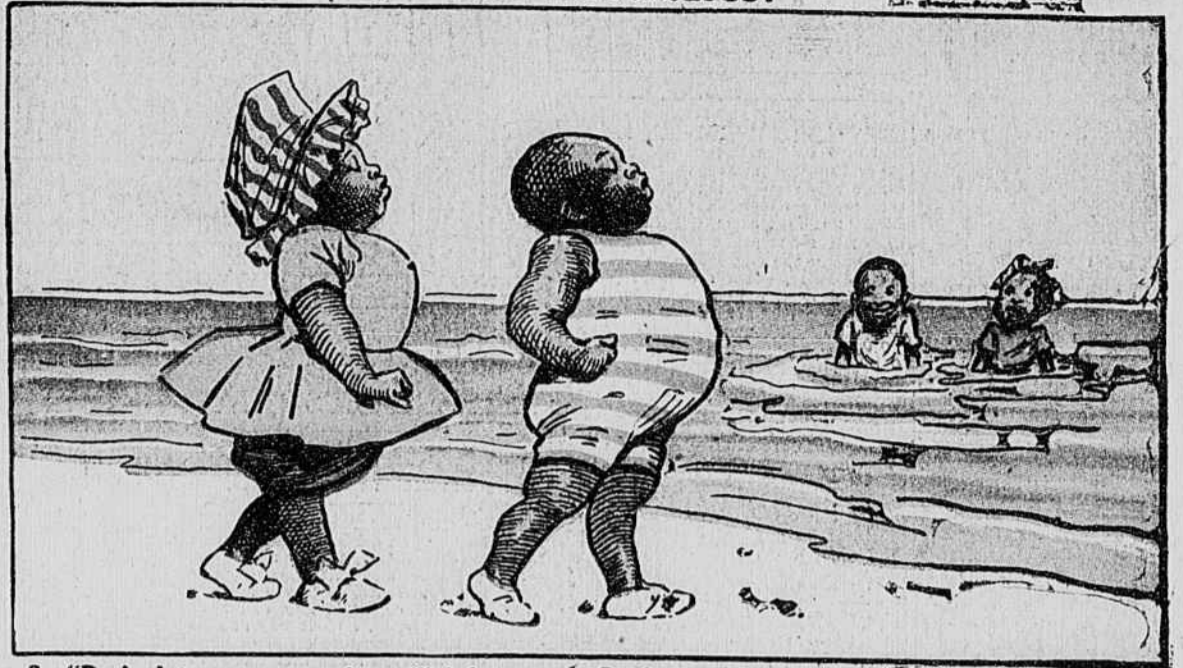

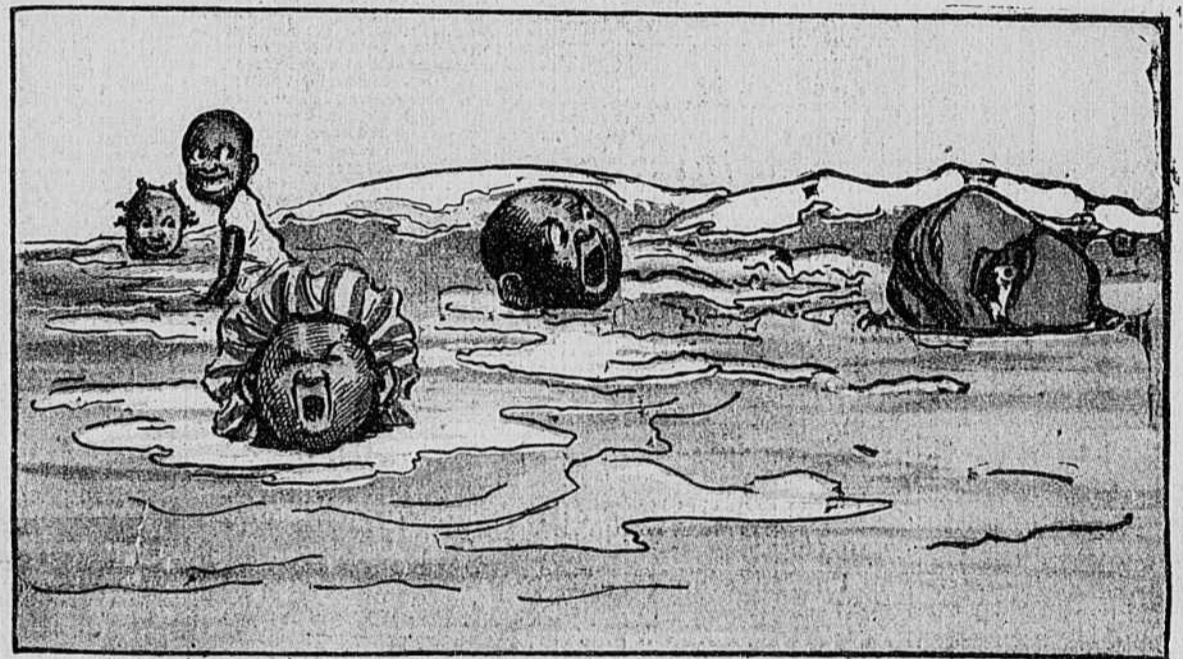
1—"Ef we didn't knowed it was you, we'd be scared to deaf."

4—"Help! Somebody help! A shark! Help! Help!"



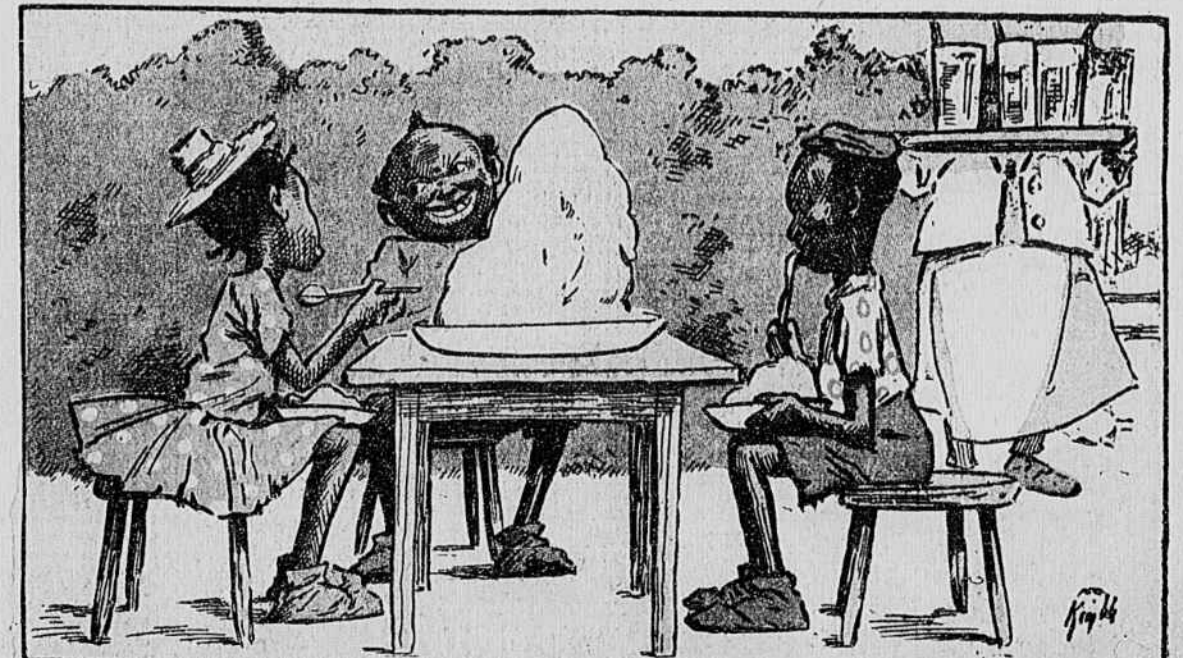
5—"Save Cutey! Save ma Cutey, and I will reward you!"
