Committees in New Body Will Have Seven Members Instead of Twelve. GOSSIP ON CHAIRMANSHIPS. Colonel Grundy and Mr. Pollock Slated to Head Committees.

Some Committee Chairmen. The retirement from the Council at the end of this term of H. R. Pollard, Jr. leaves vacant the chairmanship of the Committee on Finance, perhaps the most important position in the Council.

The election of Chairman Adams, of the Committee on Streets, as president of the Board of Aldermen leaves Vice-Chairman Gilbert K. Pollock as the ranking member of the Committee on Streets, and his election as chairman of the Board of Aldermen.

Chairman Jacob Umlauf will remain at the head of the Committee on Ordinance, Charter and Reform, over which he presides at the present time.

During the interim from September 1 to January 1, the Council will continue to have separate committees for each of the departments, as at present.

President Jacob Adams, of the Board of Aldermen, has announced that this would be a useful multiplication of members and machinery. In lieu of several departmental committees, he proposes a joint committee on public improvements.

The Committee on Rules will take up later with the City Attorney the revision of certain ordinances of the city to meet the new plan of government, making such changes in the city's laws as are necessary on the recent changes in the charter.
