ALEXANDRIA, VA., May 3, 1865.

ALL interested are notified that orders heretofore issued from these headquarters upon the subject of the disposition of liquors in the city of Alexandria, are still in force.

Spirituous, vinous, or malt liquors, are not to be sold or given away, without permission obtained from these headquarters.

Orders just received, require that the penalty of seizure of stock of liquors is to be inflicted upon all offending, after this notice is given.

The penalty of fine or imprisonment, will be inflicted when deemed necessary.

It is hoped that all will quietly acquiesce in, and obey the orders upon this subject, as the same are, for Military reasons, still considered necessary for the continued preservation of good order, and the protection of persons and property in the city.
