THE BIRTHDAY OF ENGLAND'S QUEEN

The Well-Loved Sovereign Reaches Fourscore. A GENERAL HOLIDAY.

In Windsor Where the Queen's Favorite Castle Is.

THE OFFICIAL CELEBRATIONS.

In London Postponed Until June 3rd, Celebrations Were Also Observed Throughout the Provinces—At Port Tampa, Florida, British, German and Americans Joined in Exercises.

LONDON, May 24.—Torrents of rain ushered in Queen Victoria's eightieth birthday today at Windsor, where a general holiday is being observed, the town was decorated with flags and the church bells were rung at 7 o'clock in the morning. The weather cleared at about 11 o'clock and a serenade by the Windsor and Eton amateur choral societies was given in the great quadrangle of Windsor Castle. The air then shone brilliantly. The serenade was listened to by the Queen and the members of the royal family.

The Eton College Volunteer Cadets marched into the castle grounds, headed by a band of music, and took up a position in the rear of the choir. Behind the cadets were drawn up the rest of the Eton boys and the Military Kadets of Windsor. The Mayor and Corporation of Windsor, in their full robes of office, and the borough magistrates were also present.

A PRETTY SCENE. The scene was extremely picturesque. They all sang the National Anthem and then the choir gave the hymn, "Praise to Thee, O God in Three Persons." The Queen herself, looking to be in excellent health, came forward and bowed graciously.

Mr. W. A. Parrish and the Mayor of Windsor were introduced to the Queen and she smiled her beautiful face. The Queen afterwards knitted the Mayor's initials.

At 11 o'clock the official birthday celebration in London was postponed until June 21. At public buildings and many houses, however, a great many private parties were given. In fact, more than usual were being held at any time since the Queen's infancy.

A great number of assemblies in St. Paul's Cathedral this morning, where devotional services were held. The first service of London and all the other parishes in the diocese of St. Paul's, London, was held at 10 o'clock. The Rev. Canon of St. Paul's, the Rev. Canon of St. Dunstons, St. Giles, and St. Andrew's, D. C., officiated and preached the sermon.

IN THE PROVINCES. Birthday celebrations occurred throughout the provinces, the steps in the different parts were "dressed" for the occasion and the windows were covered with bunting.

At Portsmouth, there were reviews of the regular troops, volunteers and naval detachments and the same ceremonies occurred at various arsenals and coast forts.

A telegram from Rome, the summer capital of Italy, reports that the Italian Queen's birthday celebration there was attended by the Viceroy of Italy, Lord Curzon, Lord Cromer, and the Italian military officials in full dress. Royal salutes were fired.

During the afternoon, the Queen played a solo game on the billiard table at Windsor castle, she was assisted by the Marquis of Blandford and the Duke of Devonshire. All the members of the Royal family witnessed the game.

THEY BECAME FLOWERS. A pretty incident was the presentation to the Queen this morning by one of her grand and great-grand children now at the castle of a tiny bouquet of flowers.

MCKINLEY MESSAGE. WASHINGTON, May 24.—The President addressed the following message to Queen Victoria on the occasion of the anniversary of her birthday:

"Executive Mansion, Washington, D. C., May 24, 1899. To Her Majesty, The Queen, Windsor Castle, England.

"Madam—It gives me great pleasure to convey on this happy anniversary the expression of the sentiments of regard and affection which the American people cherish towards Your Majesty, and to add the assurance of my own cordial respect and esteem. May God grant to Your Majesty and to the country under your government, many years of happiness and prosperity."

WHY NOT HAVE A SPANISH GUN?

Richmond Might Secure the Loan of One.

APPROPRIATE PLACE

No City's Claim Stronger Than the Confederate Capital.

PROMPT ACTION NECESSARY.

There Are Many Applicants Already For the Guns the Department Has in Its Possession—How to Go About Getting One—The Practice Ordered to Norfolk in June.

WASHINGTON, May 24.—Special.—There is no reason why Richmond should not have one of the cannons captured during the recent war with Spain, and a little prompt and energetic action may land one of the pieces in the city. The Navy Department some time ago disposed of the lot of guns under its control. The Secretary of War was in doubt as to his right to distribute the pieces held by the War Department, and referred the matter to the Judge Advocate-General. The latter official, after the matter had been referred to "loan" the cannon to such cities as might desire for an indefinite period.

IN GENERAL DEMAND. It is understood that about eighty cannons are now in the hands of the Government. The applications from cities for the loan of one of these pieces are so numerous that the War Department is in doubt as to which city should be given the honor. It is believed that Richmond is in a position to secure one of these pieces, and that the city should be given the honor of having one of these pieces in its possession.

Its Session Yesterday Full of Interest.

STRIKING FEATURES.

Ministers Pledge Funds to Bring the Foreign Missions' Office Here.

CHRISTIAN ENDEAVOR SOCIETY.

The Presbyterian Church to Have No Representative in It—Granting Reports on Foreign Missions, Two Hundred Thousand to Be Raised During the Coming Year.

Such good progress has the General Assembly of the Presbyterian Church, South, made with its work that there is a probability that it may be completed to-day. The recommendations of the commissioners have already been left for their homes.

Yesterday's session was a busy one, some strikingly interesting reports were presented and acted upon.

The question of removing the Foreign Missions' office from Nashville to Richmond, which has excited so much interest, was the subject of a communication from the Presbyterian ministers of this city, who pledge themselves to raise the funds necessary.

Of especial interest was the report on Sunday School work and Foreign Missions, which latter recommended the establishment of a mission in Cuba.

The decision of the Assembly yesterday regarding the removal of the Foreign Missions' office from Nashville to Richmond, which has excited so much interest, was the subject of a communication from the Presbyterian ministers of this city, who pledge themselves to raise the funds necessary.

The communication was as follows: We, the Presbyterian ministers of Richmond, having been informed by prominent members of the Assembly that there is widespread desire to have the Executive Committee of Foreign Missions removed to this city, and our wishes having been asked, we take occasion to say that we had the proposition with delight and interest received, and the association of our names with it.
