INVESTIGATION OF THE LYNCHING.

(Continued From First Page.) was Secretary of State, at which time the Italian Minister, Baron Fava, called for his passports and left the country.

Baron Fava is now in Rome on vacation and during his absence Count Vichi has charge of the Italian affairs in this country.

Count Vichi's representations to the State Department were based upon a brief dispatch from the acting consul at New Orleans, Mr. Pabini. Count Vichi at once directed that all the particulars in the case be ascertained and that special inquiry be made as to whether the victims of the lynching were Italian citizens who had not yet become naturalized.

Throughout the conference the most agreeable spirit was shown, and there seemed to be no real objection to the fact that his government was disposed to make a serious issue of the affair.

Count Vichi recalled that during his service here, two affairs of a similar nature occurred in Louisiana and the other in Louisiana had been satisfactorily adjusted and this had been brought about largely through the sympathetic and friendly feeling which prevails and which is the result of the fact that the nationality of the murdered men.

APPLIED FOR NATURALIZATION. NEW ORLEANS, La., July 22.—A party from Tallulah, La., consisting of five Italian lynched yesterday had been living in Madison parish for several years and had filed their applications to become citizens.

ROME, July 22.—The Fanfulla, commenting upon the lynching of the Italians at Tallulah, La., yesterday, recalls similar cases which have been reported in the past, and which, demanding such savage deeds, deplores the indifference of the United States government, which, the Fanfulla says, has not the strength to vanquish fanatical prejudices and sentiments in the case of the shooting of the miners at Hazelton, refuses all explanation.

The paper expresses the opinion that the Italian government should demand and insist upon the satisfaction and satisfaction for the lynching.

Other papers make no comment upon the incident.
