The illustration. He says that the size is one-third below the average, owing to a heavy crop on small trees. He also says that the trees of this variety are "a surprise in vigor, and are early and abundant bearers." The size of the fruit is large enough and the color dark, purplish red. The flavor is rich subacid, much like that of many of the Japan type, to which it belongs. It will be pronounced good in quality. The flesh is firm enough, quite juicy and tinted with purple throughout.—H. E. Van Deman, in Rural New Yorker.

**New Vegetables from Asia.**  
A New York dealer tells the Sun of two vegetables introduced about four years ago and still new to the public. One is oriental romaine, a winter salad from China, now grown at the south as far as North Carolina. A head of it is the length of an ear of corn, and is about the same size except at the lower end, which is bulbous. It is made up of long, narrow leaves, folded solidly together. It sells by the pound at 15 to 20 cents a head, weighing one pound, more or less. The other vegetable is Japanese cress, a salad garnish, and also eaten cooked, now grown chiefly in France. It is about two inches long, and half an inch in diameter, of an artichoke nature. In Japan they are eaten cooked, pickled and as a salad. They are imported in 15-pound baskets, and sell at 40 cents a pound.
