About SS Just Ripport Enroute to Little America.

Rear Admiral Richard Byrd was elated today at word from Lincoln Ells. worth, fellow explorer in the Antarctic Ice that Little America was practically as he left it four years ago. The airplanes that he left and the equipment and houses were intact. Ellsworth's m sage related the discovery was made by Bernt Balchen, veteran Polar flier now with the Ellsworth expedition, wno flew to Little America for a brief inspection and returned with the good news to the Elisworth Flagship. Approaching the Bay of Whales the message sent from the Ellsworth ship "Wyatt Earp" to the Jacob Ruppert said "Little America" is as you left it with planes in good condition except for digging out wireless masts or but tremendous pressure ridges show in front of "Ver Sur Mer Bay" making it impassable for dogs teams."
