With this proposed change in the law persons who may have worked side by side with these retired employees but who happened to have entered the service about five or more years after them will now receive a special privilege which their fellow workers did not enjoy. Thus an unfair situation is created.

This was not the case in St. Thomas where the passage of the original law and the unfortunate amendment were comparatively recent actions." However, Acting Governor de Castro stated, that in order to maintain a uniform public policy for the Virgin Islands, which is one of the prime objectives of the Executive, he had decided to allow the bill to become law without his signature.
