KEY WEST, May 8.—Only poor marksmanship on the part of the Spaniards saved the Vicksburg and the cutter Morrill from destruction in Havana harbor yesterday morning...

Sampson expects to meet the Spanish fleet near Mina Passage, between Porto Rico and San Domingo Tuesday morning.

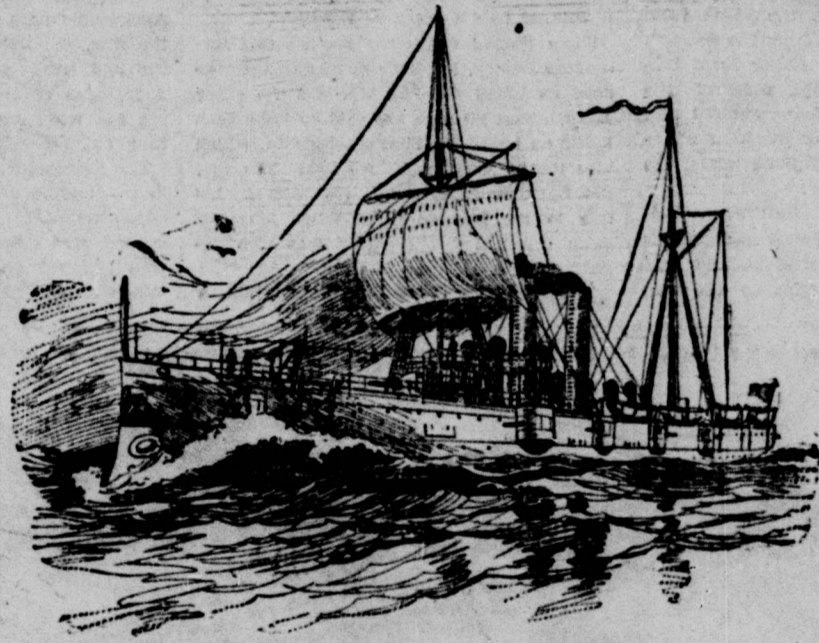
The Spanish fleet has been augmented by sixteen gunboats that left the vicinity of Cuba when the blockading squadron appeared.

A BATTLE BETWEEN CRUISERS FOUGHT.

Montgomery Engaged Some Spaniard Off Hayti.

PORT AU PRINCE, Hayti, May 8.—The United States cruiser Montgomery, Commander G. A. Converse, is supposed to have been engaged with a much larger Spanish cruiser last night northwest of Cape Haytien...

While the French steamer Ounce Rodriguez, from Havre April 16 for Haytien ports, was at Cape Haytien, a Spanish warship is said to have been watching her...

The arrival is rumored late this evening of seventeen Spanish warships, war vessels and others at Porto Rico, and a battle is expected on Tuesday.

By nightfall, it is added, four discharges of cannon were heard, which were supposed to be the result of the Spaniard firing on the American warship...
