REPUBLICAN STATE CONVENTION AT WHEELING WILDLY CHEERS SPEECH OF MRS. FUNK.

At the recent Republican state convention in Wheeling, Mrs. Antoinette Funk, a woman of national reputation as an orator, was invited to the platform and given 30 minutes in which to address the great assembly on the subject of woman suffrage.

The women in the balcony were invited to the floor. Mrs. Funk, "spokesman" for the suffrage movement in this state, was introduced amidst cheers. She pointed out that 4,000,000 women in the West would vote for Presidential electors in November and called upon the Republicans of West Virginia to meet the Western vote with adoption of the amendment here.

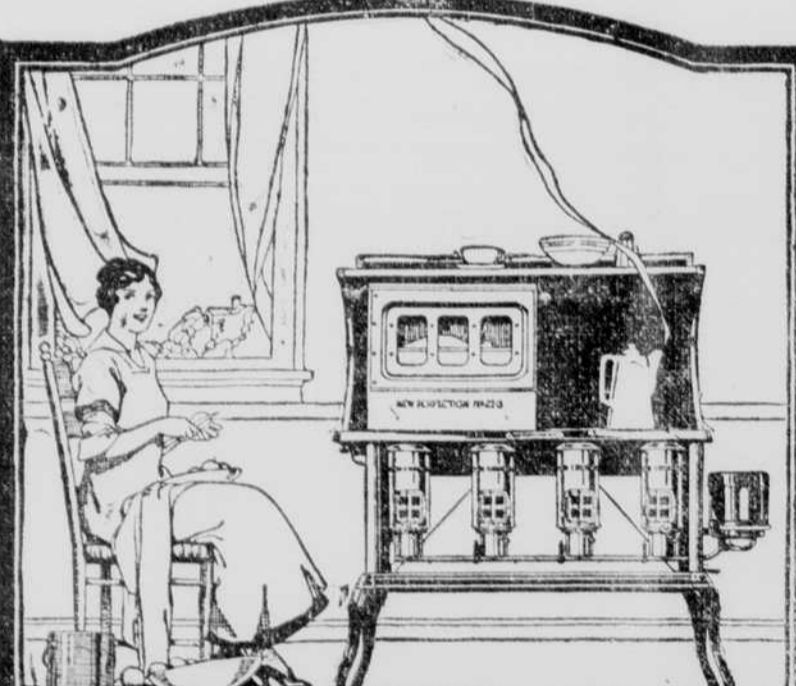
