THE committee of arrangement is authorised to state to the citizens of Nashville and its vicinity, that GENERAL JACKSON will arrive at Nashville on Monday next. Messrs. *G. M. Deaderick* and *Thomas Claiborne*, members of the committee, are deputed to meet GENERAL JACKSON, with such other citizens as may be desirous of accompanying them, at Franklin on Sunday evening, and the next day to escort him from thence to Nashville.—Messrs. *James Jackson* and *John Childress*, two other members of the committee, will meet the *General* at some convenient place, a few miles south of Nashville on Monday, and in conjunction with the Franklin escort, conduct him into town. The citizens of the town and neighborhood, are *all* respectfully invited to join them on horseback, at 10 o'clock monday morning, on the public square.
