A BILL, Authorizing the payment of two thousand eight hundred dollars to Philip Sloan.

1 Be it enacted, by the Senate and House of Representatives 2 of the United States of America, in Congress assembled, 3 That there be paid to Philip Sloan out of any unappropriated 4 money in the treasury of the United States, the sum of two thousand 5 eight hundred dollars, to indemnify him for his ransom from 6 captivity among the Algerines, and as a full compensation for his 7 services as interpreter.
